



MUSIC LIBRARY MARCHING ROYAL DUKES MADES MADISON UNIVERSITY

The Marching Royal Dukes from James Madison University of Virginia have rapidly become one of America's top collegiate marching bands. The Dukes are a youngster in college marching band circles, having only been in existence since 1972, the first year of football at JMU. James Madison University, formerly Madison College for women, was founded in 1908. In 1966, Madison became coed and the name changed to James Madison University in 1977. Today, JMU is a university of 10,000 and is recognized as a public institution with lvy League quality, admitting only 2400 from over 16,000 applications in 1987.

The Marching Royal Dukes are a part of the music department at JMU which has over 300 majors. Degrees in music include the Bachelor of Music Performance, Bachelor of Music Education and Bachelor of Music in Music Industry. The music department has over 30 ensembles including the JMU chorale, symphony orchestra, and jazz ensemble. JMU Director of Bands, Pat Rooney, also conducts the JMU wind symphony which has been recognized with performances at the Kennedy Center, and College Band Directors National Convention.

Assistant Director of Bands and drill coordinator is George Megaw, and M & M coordinator is Bill Posey. The outstanding JMU drum line is under the leadership of director of percussion studies, C. William Rice, and percussion instructor, Chris Thomas. The color guard designer and instructor is Ray Lynch from Rocky Mount, VA. Kevin Stees is the brass instructor. Graduate assistant and drill designer is Rick Knight.

In 1988, the Marching Royal Dukes were selected to be the featured band at the Bands of America Grand National Championship at the Pontiac Silverdome.


