

The 1978 season for the Marching Royal Dukes was one of the most outstanding in the band history. The band performed five half-time shows at Madison Stadium, they were the feature exhibition band for the Mid-Eastern Regional of Marching Bands of America held at the James Madison University Stadium October 28. The Royal Dukes also had half-time performances October 15 at the Baltimore Colts vs. New York Jets game and December 3 at the Washington Redskins vs. Miami Dolphins game in Washington, D. C.

The Band consists of 124 horns, 24 percussion, 28 color guard, 10 rifles, 2 feature twirlers, 2 drum majors and 2 auxiliaries.
