Power on

- On the control console, press the "ON" button.
- After the ON light stops blinking on the control console, select the source you would like to use.


Note: The System's "ON" button will also power on the DVD/VCR. The desktop computer and document camera must be powered on separately.



Desktop PC


- On the front of the PC, press the power button.
- At the Windows login prompt, click the arrow or press "enter." Do not change the User ID name, and leave the password area blank.
- To turn the computer off, select "Shut Down..." from the Windows "Start" menu, then click "OK."

Note: The PC's hard drive is protected; anything stored or installed on the hard drive is automatically erased on reboot. Save your files directly to a USB flash drive.



Laptop

- Connect your laptop to the system using the VGA, audio, and




